MINUTES OF COMMON COUNCIL MEETING
OCTOBER 20, 2022**

Motion Hickethier, Seconded Smith to approve bills totaling \$31,962.26. Roll Call Vote Carried 4 ayes, 1 absent.

Mayor Larson thanked Kvapil and the ATV Club for being such a positive part of our community.
