

**CITY OF CORNELL
MINUTES OF COMMON COUNCIL MEETING
NOVEMBER 17, 2022**

7:00 p.m. Mayor Mark Larson called the regular council meeting to order at the City Council Chambers. The meeting opened with the pledge of allegiance and a moment of silence honoring all individuals that have or are protecting our freedom. Minutes taken by Administrator/Clerk-Treasurer DeJongh.

Council members present: Bill Kvapil, Ashley Carothers, Floyd Hickethier and Terry Smith. Absent: Steve Turany.

Guests present: Ginna Young and Police Chief Glenn Rehberg.

Motion Hickethier, seconded Carothers to accept the agenda as printed. Carried 4 ayes, 1 absent.

Motion Carothers, seconded Hickethier to approve the regular council meeting minutes of November 3, 2022. Carried 4 ayes, 1 absent.

Motion Carothers, Seconded Hickethier to approve presenting full-time and regularly scheduled part-time employees with a \$25 gift card at KJ's Market for the holiday season. Carried 4 ayes, 1 absent.

Motion Carothers, Seconded Smith to approve a Memorandum of Understanding with Chip Cty to provide Statewide Voter Registration System services for 2023 for the City for \$490. Carried 4 ayes, 1 absent.

Action on Jordan Yule's alcohol license application was tabled.

Elected officials were provided a copy of the Type A Notice of Spring Election. 3 Council seats and Municipal Judge are up for election this Spring. First day to circulate nomination papers is December 1st.

Mayor/Council received for information a follow-up email from Matt Reddy DOT on the recent speed study done on STH 64/178. Matt was not aware of any grants or funding sources available for dynamic speed display signs. WisDOT would permit the use of the speed sign trailer until a permanent sign could be purchased. They also mentioned that they would permit a flashing beacon on the 45 mph speed limit sign to bring attention to it.

Motion Hickethier, Seconded Kvapil to approve bills totaling \$27,546.57. Roll Call Vote Carried 4 ayes, Turany absent.
