

ORDINANCE #24-2
CITY OF CORNELL

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING NEW SEWER RATES WHICH
WILL GENERATE REVENUES TO COVER OPERATING AND
MAINTENANCE EXPENSES, REPLACEMENT REQUIREMENTS,
AND DEBT SERVICE PAYMENTS.

The Common Council of the City of Cornell, Wisconsin does ordain as follows:

WHEREAS, the sewer utility is not regulated by Wisconsin Public Service Commission, and

WHEREAS, the sewer utility needs to generate revenues which will cover the operating and maintenance expenses, replacement fund requirements and debt service.

NOW THEREFORE, the City Council agrees to adopt the following sewer rates:

<u>Domestic & Non-Domestic Sewage Customer</u>	
Fixed Charge	\$20.83/Month
Volume Charge	\$9.65/1000 gal.
<u>Flat Rate for Unmetered Customers</u>	
Small User (Household size two (2) or less)	\$40.12/Month
Large User (Household size three (3) or more)	\$59.41/Month
<u>Tanker Truck Haulers</u>	
Volume Charge:	
Holding Tank Discharge	\$19.85/1000 gal.
Septic Tank Discharge	\$68.75/1000 gal.
